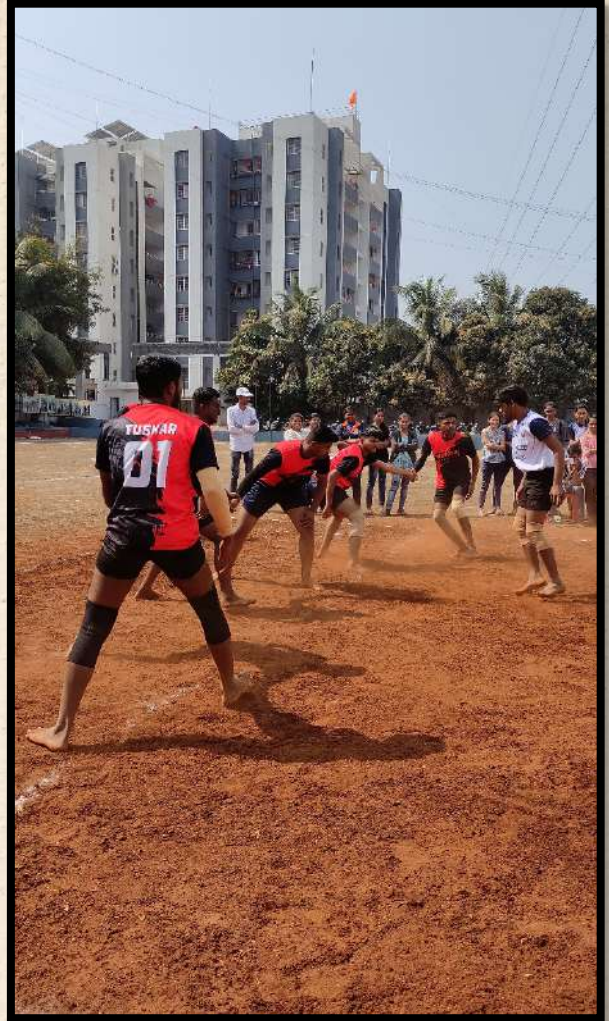


Sports Week
