



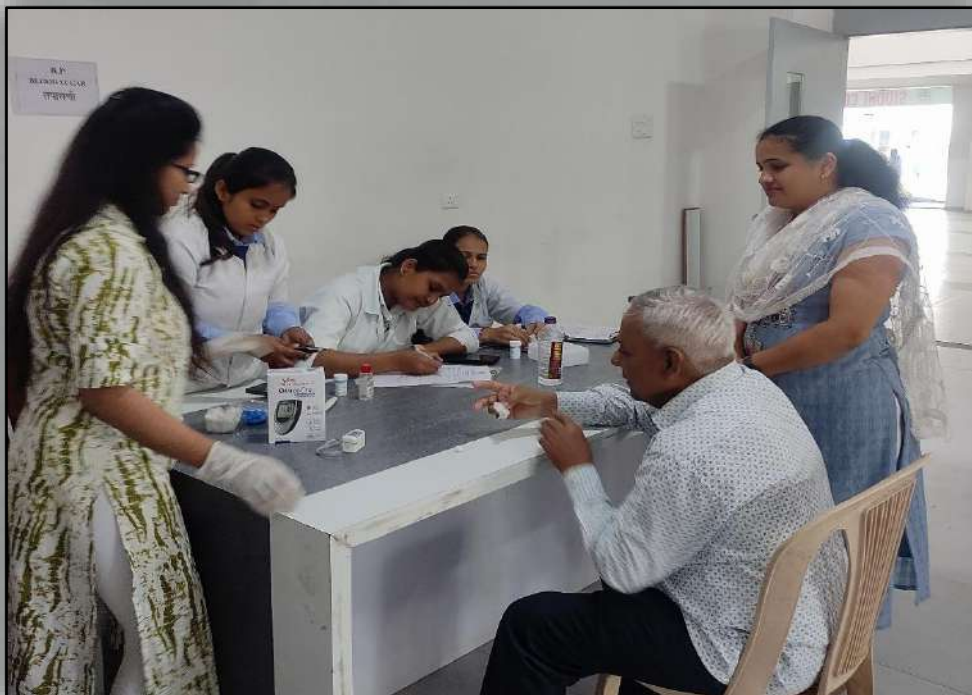


27TH SEPTEMBER

The session emphasized self-awareness and daily mindfulness as tools to nurture emotional resilience. Their relatable approach and real-life tips made the session both enlightening and impactful.






